AM I ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible for FSM if you receive:

- * Income Support, **or**
- * Income Based Jobseekers' Allowance, **or**
- * Child Tax Credit without Working Tax Credit and have an annual income of below £16,190 **or**
- * Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- * The guarantee element of state Pension Credit

WILL IT BE AWKWARD FOR
MY CHILD?

Your child selects their meal as normal and gives their name to their teacher during registration & states whether they want hot dinner or packed lunch (stating choice of sandwich filling).

WHAT'S IN IT FOR PUPILS?

The food is good with lots of choice.



We can accommodate special dietary requirements. Registering for Free School Meals can bring additional funding for your child's education.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR PARENTS?

Your child gets good food up to the value of £400 per school year. No rushing to make a packed lunch or find dinner money every morning!

2. Fill it in and return it to the Town Hall with proof of your eligibility.

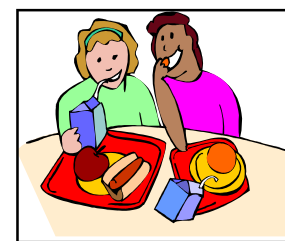
3. They will let you know when your application is approved.
