Dear Parents,

Thank you to all parents who completed the questionnaire about school last term. I have attached a copy of the results which are extremely positive.

The parents of 33 children responded, representing 54% of the school and approximately 29 families. The results for each question are recorded on the questionnaire as a percentage, with the response of 1 person rounded to roughly 3%. Only the results for 'Don't Know' and 'Agree and Strongly Agree' have been included.

The questionnaire has helped us to review how the school works and how well some of the things we offer are used, for example, the Dundry Days, class teacher and text messaging are still most often used to find out information about the school. However, we have a larger percentage of parents using e-mail and the website to find out information. Your responses also helped us to evaluate the effectiveness of some of the activities we provide to help you support your child at home, for example the phonic, maths and ICT workshops and the links section of the website.

The questionnaire has also helped us to see the school from your point of view and we'll be discussing with staff and governors the things we do well alongside some of the great ideas you have contributed for change. We will also be making good use of the Parent and School Councils to address some of the points you have raised so that the school can address them fully.

Some of the changes we can make quite quickly, for example the website and the Induction for Parents. Some changes will take longer as they will need careful planning to ensure they work in the long term and are right for all of our children.

As a result of your comments and ideas, staff, governors and the Parent Council have begun thinking about how to shape our school in the future in order to achieve our aim for all pupils. In the meantime, I have attached a brief table outlining your suggestions for how we can improve and what action we have either already taken, or intend to take. We will keep you updated as the projects progress. If, in the meantime you would like to discuss any of the points raise or make any further suggestions, please let me know - I'm always available on the playground and enjoy hearing about your ideas.

Thank you, again, to all those parents who completed and returned a questionnaire. We very much value your ideas and will be sending out a similar questionnaire every academic year. Together we can really make a difference to the lives and futures of our children.
